Is running two experiential training days Introducing the Play Therapy Techniques of Worlds and Mosaics devised by Dr Margaret Lowenfeld.

The first day will focus on introduction of Lowenfeld methods, and will be mainly experiential. Experiential work involves each participant using their own life experiences as material for making Lowenfeld worlds and mosaics. Participants need only share as much or as little of this as they feel comfortable doing, as this is not a therapeutic situation, but a method of learning how to use Lowenfeld techniques.

The course is designed for people who have some previous experience and training in play therapy methods.
